

## ABOUT ALLEN BACH

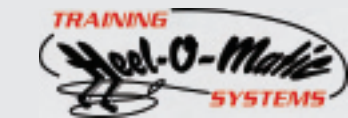

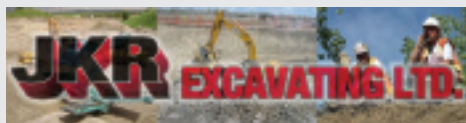

**WORLD CHAMPION TEAM ROPER** Allen Bach is well-known and respected for his expertise, accomplishments and awards in the arena. He counts them as blessings, but sees them as nothing but tools in helping others. Although he has a true passion for the sport, he has a real heart for the ropers.

His true desire is to serve not only as an instructor, but as a mentor and coach to young aspiring ropers and cowboys in all walks of life—in and out of the arena.

This desire has resulted in Allen's hosting month-long training camps at his home in Millsap, Texas. His goal for the camps is three-fold: "To impact the students' roping in the most powerful way it's ever been impacted, to help them develop a training program that they can implement at home, and for the Lord to impact their lives in the most powerful way He can."

Rather than pointing all kids down the rodeo road, Allen would like to help young ropers accomplish their dreams. He wants to help each young person achieve their personal goals, roping or otherwise.

**WHO CAN ATTEND?** The camp is intended for young cowboys, ages 18-22 (with a few possible exceptions), who are extremely serious about improving their team roping skills and relationships with God and others. A limited number of participants will be selected by Bach, based on their applications. Younger or adult ropers please contact us at 940-456-6056 for private lessons or schools geared toward other ages.

**WHAT IS TRAINING CAMP, AND WHAT CAN I EXPECT?** This is not your "normal" roping school. It is a month-long intensive camp, where participants stay on the grounds and receive daily roping instruction (Monday-Friday), combined with Bible mentoring (limited to four 30-minute sessions per day of morning devotions, Bible study, and praise/worship). There will also be plenty of fun (such as basketball and volleyball) and time to establish relationships that last a lifetime.

**WHEN IS THE CAMP?** The camp is scheduled for September 28-October 22, 2009.

**WHERE?** Roping Oaks Ranch, 700 Whitebull Lane, Millsap, Texas, 76066. Students will stay on the grounds in their trailers or other accommodations. Parents, families and friends are welcome to drop by, but the camps will be structured for the ropers to spend most of their time with the pros and their fellow students.

**WHY ATTEND?** Allen will be giving one-on-one instruction to students that will cover everything from rope handling and horsemanship to goal setting and mental aspects. As an added bonus, he will have some of his best friends, including the biggest names in the sport of rodeo, come and help coach. "This is my heart," Allen said. "I want these kids to hate to leave and to have the most fun they've ever had, and to get to know the top guys like brothers, and to know how we are outside of roping. I even want the down time to be fun; that's what life's all about."

**HOW DO I APPLY?** Prospective students must fill out a questionnaire detailing their goals and other information. Applications will be reviewed by Allen, and he will select a limited number of participants.
